Zeeland City

Size shall not exceed the permitted size of signs by more than 50%

Number of signs on a parcel shall no exceed the permitted number of signs times the number of street frontages for a parcel.
Sign shall not create any traffic or safety hazard, or hardship for any adjacent property owner.

The preservation of the right of free speech exercised through the use of signs containing non commercial messages and such other standards as are provided in the zoning ordinance for the granting of a special condition land use.
